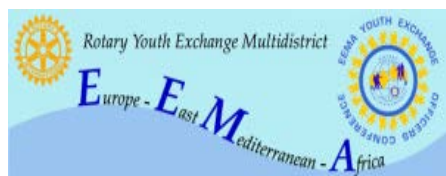

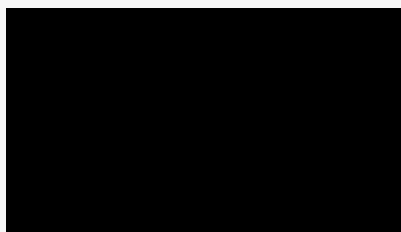

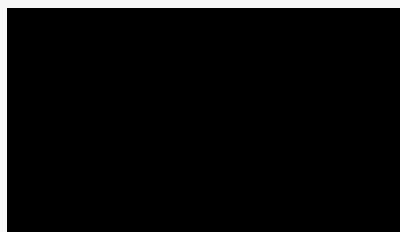

TOUR A The Fjords of Norway 25.08.2014 - 28.08.2014

Monday 25 of August

The first day is a bus trip from Oslo to Gol where we change to the famous Bergen Railway . The train takes us over the mountains to Myrdal where we change trains to Flåm and Nærofjord. This is one of the highlights of the tour. On the 20 km long train ride, you will see some of the most magnificent mountain scenery Norway has to offer.

This is a part of “Norway in a nutshell”.

Lunch in Flåm.



After lunch, you will take part in a Fjord cruise from Flåm to Gudvangen. You travel passed the beautiful villages of Aurland and Undredal before the boat enters the Nærøyfjord , one of the narrowest fjords in Europe.

The Fjordarm of the Sognefjord is perhaps the most dramatic Fjord in Norway .

From Gudvangen the bus brings us to Bergen, also called also the capital of Fjord

Norway.

Overnight and dinner at the Scandic City Hotel in the city of Bergen.

Tuesday 26 of August

The second day brings a sightseeing tour in Bergen , and a visit of the famous fish market . This tour is by bus over the mountain and then crossing the Sognefjord, to Nordfjord.

Overnight stay at Nordfjord Hotel.

Wednesday 27 of August

The third day starts with a great highlight, the Fjord Cruise from Hellesylt to Geiranger, on the famous Geirangerfjord. The deep blue UNESCO - protected Geirangerfjord is surrounded by majestic snow covered mountain peaks , wild waterfall and lush, green vegetation.

A great time to take pictures, Flydalsjuvet. Geiranger is the jewel in the crown of the Norwegian fjords. It is a fairytale landscape and one of the most beautiful tourist destinations in the world.

Lunch at Grotli hotel.

In the afternoon, we visit the stave church in Lom before we arrive in Lillehammer for the overnight stay.

Our special farewell dinner is at Trollhallen in Hunderfossen.

Thursday 28 of August

The group that also travels to the Island of Lofoten leaves Lillehammer early to reach a plane from Oslo airport Gardermoen to Bodø.

The others leave Lillehammer at 9 am .

Tour A ends in Oslo at 12 am.

Tour B Lofoten 28.08 - 30.08.14

The Lofoten archipelago lies north of the Polar circle and between Lofoten Island and the north norwegian is the vast open Vestfjorden, to the north the islands of Vesterålen and west of the archipelago is the north Atlantic Ocean. The principal towns in Lofoten are Lekneson the island Vestvågøy and Svolvær on the island of Austvågøy.

Lofoten is a place where you can forget everyday life and experience something totally unexpected and different. The views are amazing and there are plenty of them. The Islands are characterized by their mountain peaks, sheltered inlets, stretches of seashore and large open spaces.

In the summertime, Lofoten is where the sun never sinks below the horizon and where you can experience both the closeness to the mountains and to the sea. Its unique bird wildlife, the quietness, and the fascinating nature are absolutely breathtaking.



Thursday 28.08.14

We leave from Oslo Airport Gardermoen with SAS at 10.45 and arrive in Bodø at 12.10

A bus will bring us to a nice restaurant for a local lunch before we go on board the coastal steamer which will take us across the Vestfjord with the most beautiful scenery

before arriving in Svolvær at 21.00

Dinner and overnight at the Rica Svolvær Hotel, which is on the waterfront.

Friday 29.08.14

After breakfast we leave by bus for a special day trip around the Island. At Borg in Lofoten, you will learn about the Viking era at a living museum. Here you will experience the smell of tar, tasting the food and feeling the history as the Vikings lived for more than a 1000 years.

Then we go on to Nusfjord one of Norway's oldest and best preserved fishing hamlets with a long-standing tradition of "Lofotfiske", (the seasonal cod fishing).

At Nusfjord 50 charming fishermen's cabins are the destination for many thousands of visitors who want to experience authentic Lofoten each year.

Lunch is at Nusfjord.

In the early afternoon, we have time to visit two exiting art galleries on our way to Kabelvåg. There, we will board a special ferry boat "M/ F Lofotferja".

The ferry received the prize of most successful restoring of an object during a festival in 1994.

Captains dinner on board is served with a special local menu including: barbecued salmon, served with potato puree, vegetables and fresh bread and butter.

While entering the Trollfjord by boat, we will experience a dark and narrow sheet of water below, and jagged peaks and impenetrable mountain walls around us.

The Trollfjorden is only accessible from the sea. in the southernmost part of

Vesterålen, it is one of Norway's magical highlights

In the evening we go back to Svolvær and our hotel.



Saturday 30 August.

We leave Svolvær after breakfast to go to Evenes Airport to fly back to Oslo at 11.05 am arriving in Oslo at 12.50
